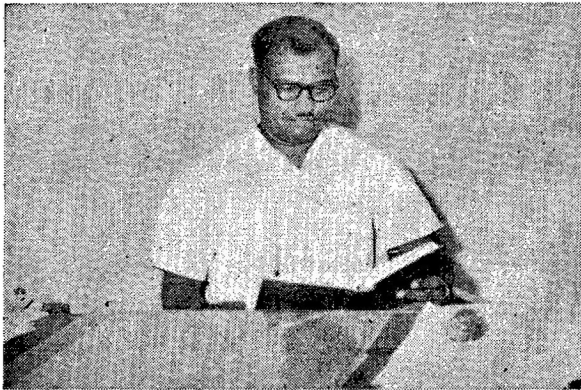

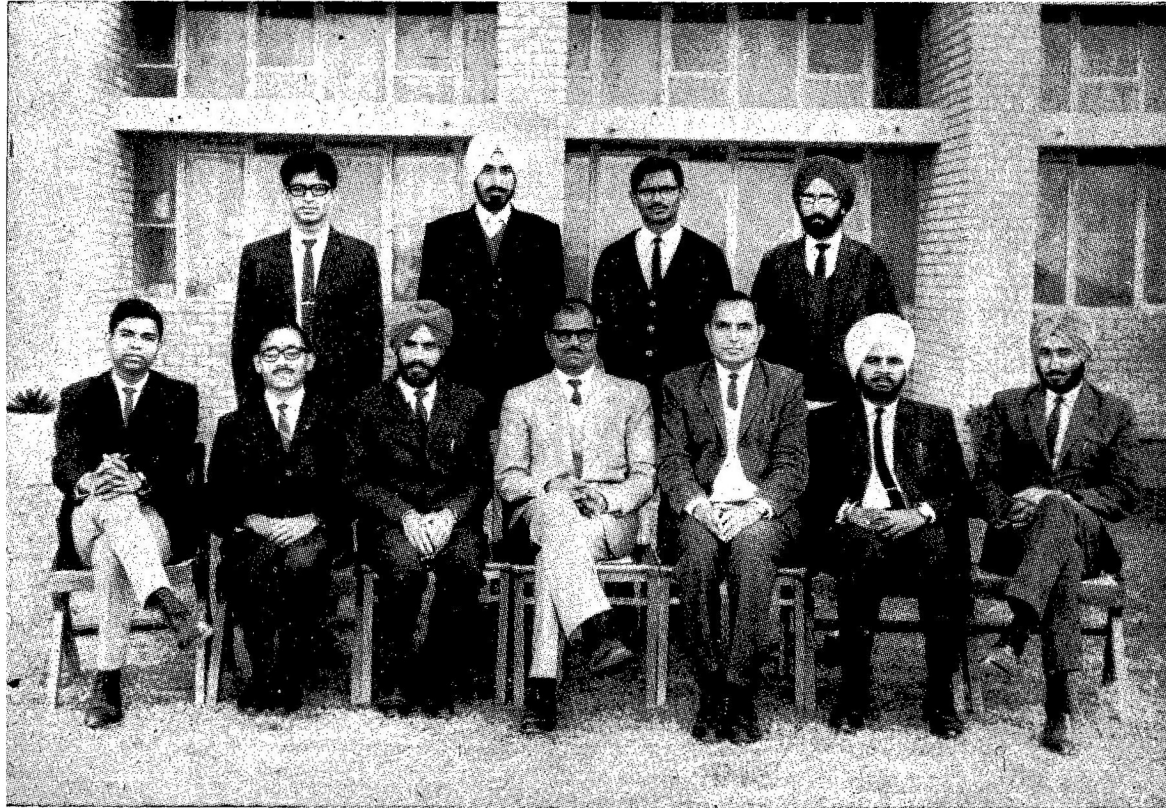
Message for the Souvenir
